Boydtown Beach Holiday Park Pets Policy



Exclusion periods – 22nd December -12 January & Easter Long weekend

Here at Boydtown Beach Holiday Park, we understand that your pet is part of the family & we are more than happy to welcome your fur baby.

We have powered and unpowered sites that are pet friendly.

We are also located just a few steps away from Boydtown Beach which is pet friendly, where they can run, dig & swim.

To ensure all guests & pets alike have an enjoyable stay, we ask that all pets are tied up, or on a lead and controlled at all times during your holiday.

All pets must be well behaved and cannot be left unattended at any time in the park. This means that when you leave the park for daily activities, you are required to take your pet with you, they cannot be left tied up on your site or locked in your caravan.

Pets off-leash and running around will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave.

To ensure that our park is enjoyable for everyone, it is a requirement that you keep barking to the absolute minimum, pick up after your pet and clean up any traces that your pet has left behind.

To ensure the health & safety of everyone's pets <u>ALL</u> pets must be registered, vaccinated and in good health.

Owners take full responsibility for any personal injury caused by their pet whilst within the confines of the park and are responsible for any claims of compensation.

Any damage caused by your pet must be reported to management.

Pets are not permitted in amenities blocks, kitchen areas or tiny homes.

This is with an exception to assistant animals – state based accreditation required.

Please note that pets bedding and blankets are not to be washed in the laundry facilities in the park.
